In-home Family Training Program

HOME-BASED SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

This intensive in-home program serves school-aged children, ages 3 to 21, who are involved with the Department of Developmental Services. The program provides behavioral assessment, training and support for parents and family members; brief, home-based family counseling, service coordination and connections to resources in the community.

OUR PROGRAM IS DESIGN TO:

- Stabilize the child's behavior and enhance parents' or caregivers' ability to manage challenging situations at home
- Decrease or eliminate target behaviors
- Keep children in the home or community setting
- Divert emergency room visits and prevent hospitalization
- Help the family develop a crisis management or safety plan
- Build on family systems, strengths and supports
- Offer psychiatric assessment or medication management as needed
- Assist the child in gaining and developing more control over his or her emotional responses

WE SERVE CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES IN GREATER HARTFORD.
